



*ROBINS CITY COUNCIL
Minutes of the October 23rd, Meeting*

Mayor Hinz called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. in the Robins City Hall on Wednesday, October 23rd, 2019. Roll call was taken with Councilors Brad Sevcik, Don Norton, Marilyn Cook, Dick Pilcher and Roger Overbeck present along with Attorney Ryan Tang, Planning and Zoning Administrator Dean Helander, Public Works Superintendent/Building Official Vince Bading, City Clerk/Treasurer Lori Pickart and guest Greg Ervin.

The Council reviewed Plat of Survey No. 2364. Norton moved to table this item, Pilcher seconded and all voted aye. Norton moved to adjourn to closed session at 5:32 p.m., Pilcher seconded. Attorney Ryan Tang stated "I've reviewed the subject matter and find it in accordance with state law." On the vote, all voted aye.

Norton moved to reconvene into open session at 5:49 p.m., Overbeck seconded, all voted aye. Sevcik moved to take Resolution No. 1019-10 off table, Overbeck seconded and all voted aye. Cook moved to approve Resolution No. 1019-10 approving Plat of Survey #2364, Sevcik seconded. Mayor Hinz addressed the concerns submitted by resident Greg Ervin at the October 21st meeting, noting this Plat of Survey does not involve costs to the city or its residents; does not remove any land rights; the location of the garage is not a P&Z issue, therefore not discussed there; the existing asphalted drive is 11' wide, this plat offers over 24' width; and the Plat of Survey provides the same access to 3319 Aster Lane. All voted aye on the motion. Mr. Ervin then asked why items 1 and 6 relating to Aster Lane were not considered. Mayor Hinz noted Aster Lane has nothing to do with the location of the proposed garage or the Plat of Survey relating to Windhaven Lane.

Sevcik moved to adjourn at 5:56 p.m., Pilcher seconded and all voted aye.
