



ROBINS CITY COUNCIL
MINUTES OF THE MARCH 16TH, 2020 MEETING

Mayor Hinz called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. in the Robins City Hall on Monday, March 16th, 2020. Roll call was taken with Councilors Marilyn Cook, Roger Overbeck and Don Norton present along with Attorney Ryan Tang, Engineer Dax Suntken, Police Chief Andy Humphrey, and City Clerk/Treasurer Lori Pickart. Absent were Councilors Brad Sevcik and Dick Pilcher.

Norton moved to approve the Agenda, Cook seconded and all voted aye. Cook moved to approve the Consent Agenda, Overbeck seconded. Overbeck noted one small mistake in the minutes of the March 2nd, 2020 meeting. On the vote, all voted aye.

NEW BUSINESS

- a. **Pruitt Easement.** Suntken noted the permanent easement is for an 8” drain tile from Leslie Court south to the waterway. Norton moved to approve Resolution No. 0320-10 accepting the easement, Overbeck seconded and all voted aye.
- b. **Miller Easement.** Suntken noted this permanent easement is to enable the looping of the D&M Water Main Extension from Beverly Street to Quass Road and is in the amount of \$1,500. Overbeck asked if the city can do this even if the property is not in Robins. Suntken noted this is allowable. Cook moved to approve Resolution No. 0320-11 approving the permanent easement with Lois Miller, Overbeck seconded and all voted aye.
- c. **Contract D&M Water Main Extension.** Norton moved to approve Resolution No. 0320-8 approving the Contract and Performance and/or Payment Bonds for the D&M Watermain Extension, Overbeck seconded the motion. Suntken noted there was a minor revision in the wording awarding the base bid. On the vote, all voted aye.
- d. **Supplemental Agreement.** Suntken noted this Agreement is for construction, observation and administration of the D&M Water Main Extension. He added it allows for 30 hours per week. He noted the contractor wishes to start on March 23rd and the completion date is August 14th. He noted the preconstruction meeting is scheduled for Thursday, March 19th. Cook moved to approve Resolution No. 0320-9 approving the Supplemental Agreement with Snyder and Associates, Overbeck seconded and all voted aye.

There was no Old Business. Norton moved to adjourn at 5:48 p.m., Overbeck seconded and all voted aye.
