



ROBINS CITY COUNCIL MINUTES OF THE JULY 6TH, 2020 MEETING

Mayor Hinz called the meeting to order in the Robins City Hall on Monday, July 6th, 2020 at 7:00 p.m. After the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag, roll call was taken with Councilors Brad Sevcik, Marilyn Cook, Roger Overbeck, Don Norton, and Dick Pilcher present along with Engineer Dax Suntken, Attorney Ryan Tang, Planning and Zoning Administrator Dean Helander, Attorney Holly Corkery, Attorney Dean Spina, and City Clerk/Treasurer Lori Pickart.

Norton moved to approve the Agenda, Sevcik seconded and all voted aye.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

- Mayor Hinz noted the parks have been opened noting heavy traffic on the trails.
- Streets Coordinator Brad Sevcik reported not much has been going on the streets.
- Finance Coordinator Marilyn Cook noted the city has completed FY 20 budget year and now have a new budget to work with.
- Public Works Coordinator Roger Overbeck noted with minimal rainfall there have been no drainage issues. He noted the D&M water main installation project is winding down along with the water and sewer extension to Burd Lane, adding Kings Way water main extension is gearing up.
- Parks Coordinator Don Norton noted the parks have been busy. He added the basketball court has been re-asphalted and added goal posts and volley ball posts will soon be installed. He noted he has not yet received information relating to the cost of installing camera systems.
- Public Safety Coordinator Dick Pilcher reported the speed detection trailer has been in use. He noted he received a call relating to the Quass Road/West Main Street intersection and the "dangerous" curve.
- Engineer Suntken noted the lighting timer was installed and tested at the South Troy Park. He added he is working with the contractors of the D&M Water Main Extension with punch list items, noting the permanent seeding will be done later in the fall. He noted he has the plans and specifications for the Kings Way Water Main Extension should anyone want to look at them.

There were no citizen comments. Pilcher moved to approve the Consent Agenda which contained the Minutes of the June 15th, 2020 meeting; the Financial Report; the List of Bills Submitted; and Resolution No. 0720-2 providing notice of hearing on the proposed Plans, Specifications, Form of Contract, and Estimate of Cost for the Kings Way Water Loop on August 3rd, 2020, 7:00 p.m. in the Robins City Hall and the taking of bids. Cook seconded the motion and all voted aye.

OLD BUSINESS

- a. Mayor Hinz opened the public hearing to hear comments and concerns relating to approving an amendment to the terms of Revenue Bonds (Young Men's Christian Association of the Cedar Rapids Metropolitan Area Project) Series 2013, of the City of Robins, Iowa, and specifically approving the amendment of said bonds and related matters at 7:11 p.m. Attorney Dean

Spina noted the YMCA is asking for a 6 month deferral of their bond payment. There were no written or verbal comments received, the Public Hearing closed at 7:14 p.m.

- b. Resolution Approving. Norton moved to approve Resolution No. 0720-3 approving the aforementioned amendment, Sevcik seconded and all voted aye.

NEW BUSINESS

- a. The Council reviewed Resolution No. 0720-1 establishing salaries for FY 21. Mayor Hinz noted he recommended the 4% increase as did Councilors Pilcher, Sevcik, Cook and Overbeck. Norton noted he would prefer the 3% increase. They agreed to approve the resolution at the next meeting with the 4% increase being retroactive to July 1, 2020.
- b. Mayor Hinz introduced Holly Corkery of Lynch Dallas, P.C. She noted Resolution No. 0720-4, terminating an employee should contain the effective date of July 8th, 2020 instead of the July 6th date. Sevcik move to amend Resolution No. 0720-4 making the date change, Overbeck seconded and all voted aye. Sevcik moved to approve Resolution No. 0720-4 removing an appointed official, Pilcher seconded and all voted aye.

Sevcik moved to adjourn at 7:35 p.m. Pilcher seconded and all voted aye.
