



ROBINS CITY COUNCIL
MINUTES OF THE SEPTEMBER 16TH, 2019 MEETING

Mayor Hinz called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. in the Robins City Hall on Monday, September 16th, 2019. Roll call was taken with Councilors Brad Sevcik, Dick Pilcher, Roger Overbeck, Marilyn Cook and Don Norton present along with Police Officer Jim Dunn, Planning and Zoning Administrator Dean Helander, Engineer Dax Suntken, Attorney Ryan Tang, City Clerk/Treasurer Lori Pickart and two guests present. Norton moved to approve the agenda, Overbeck seconded and all voted aye. There were no Citizen Comments.

Sevcik moved to approve the Consent Agenda which contained the Minutes of the Minutes of the September 3rd, 2019 Meeting; Motion to approve Resolution No. 0919-8 setting a public hearing on proposal to enter into a General Obligation Corporate Purpose and Refunding Loan Agreement not to exceed \$2,750,000; and motion to approve Resolution No. 0919-9, approving the contract and performance and/or payment bonds with Rathje Construction for the Sanitary Sewer Extension from I-380 to Burd Lane. Pilcher seconded the motion and all voted aye.

Hilary Hershner from the Corridor MPO reviewed the updated Tower Terrace Road plan with the Council. She noted the road will be from Miller Road to Highway 13 adding the initial build will be a two lane road with two 10' trails. The Council discussed the costs associated with the project along with the connections to Robins.

Sevcik moved to adjourn at 6:30 p.m., Pilcher seconded and all voted aye.
