



ROBINS CITY COUNCIL
Minutes of the February 19th, 2018 Meeting

Mayor Hinz called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. in the Robins City Hall on Monday, February 19th, 2018. Roll call was taken with Councilors Roger Overbeck, Don Norton, Marilyn Cook, Brad Sevcik and Dick Pilcher present, along with Mayor Chuck Hinz, Building Official Vince Bading, Planning and Zoning Administrator Dean Helander, Engineer Kelli Scott, Attorney Kara Bullerman and City Clerk/Treasurer Lori Pickart.

Norton moved to approve the Agenda, Sevcik seconded, all voted aye. Mayor Hinz opened the public hearing to hear comments and concerns relating to the proposed budget amendment at 5:32 p.m. Pickart noted when the city sold bonds they sold more than originally budgeted due to the anticipated costs of the railroad and underground relocation of the electricity. The amendment adds the additional funds of \$411,670 to the Capital Projects Fund for the Main Street Project. She noted the public works increase is due to additional road costs with Linn County. The public hearing closed at 5:34 p.m. Sevcik moved to approve Resolution No. 0218-1 approving the budget amendment, Pilcher seconded and all voted aye.

Sevcik moved to adjourn to closed session at 5:35 p.m. Attorney Bullerman noted she has reviewed the subject matter and finds it in accordance with state law section 21.51J. Cook seconded. On the vote, all voted aye.

Cook moved to return to open session at 7:12 p.m., Norton seconded and all voted aye. Sevcik moved to adjourn the meeting at 7:13 p.m., Overbeck seconded, all voted aye.
