

ROBINS CITY COUNCIL Minutes of the March 19th, 2018 Meeting

Mayor Hinz called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. in the Robins City Hall on Monday, March 19th, 2018. After the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag, roll call was taken with Councilors Roger Overbeck, Marilyn Cook, Don Norton, Dick Pilcher and Brad Sevcik along with Mayor Hinz and City Clerk/Treasurer Lori Pickart and one guest.

Norton moved to approve the agenda, Overbeck seconded and all voted aye. There were no Citizen Comments.

Under Business Items, Steve Federspeil introduced himself as the new owner of Lebowski's Bar and Grill. He noted they are hoping to open in the next week or so, adding they will have breakfast on Sundays and will be open on Mondays. The Council welcomed him to Robins and noted they are looking forward to the re-opening of Lebowski's. Sevcik moved to approve Resolution No. 0318-5, approving the application for a Class "C" Liquor License including Outdoor Service and including Sunday Sales for Lebowski's Bar and Grill, Norton seconded. On the vote, all voted aye.

Due to unforeseen circumstances, the presentation relating to the Regional Transportation Authority was postponed until a later date.

Sevcik moved to adjourn at 5:46 p.m., Pilcher seconded and all voted aye.
