



## ROBINS CITY COUNCIL Minutes of the October 18<sup>th</sup>, 2021 Meeting

Mayor Hinz called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. in the Robins City Hall on Monday, October 18<sup>th</sup>, 2021. After the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag, roll call was called with Councilors Don Norton, Brad Sevcik, Roger Overbeck, Dick Pilcher and Marilyn Cook present along with Engineer Kelli Scott, Police Chief Andy Humphrey, Building Official/Public Works Superintendent Mike Kortenkamp and City Clerk/Treasurer Lori Pickart.

Chief Humphrey informed the Council and Staff of the death of Officer Harvey Hall who had been struggling with health issues, noting visitation would be at Pinicon Ridge on Wednesday from 3:00 - 7:00. Norton moved to approve the Agenda, Overbeck seconded and all voted aye.

Joe Horaney of CR/LC Solid Waste Agency presented the Council with information relating to "Forward Waste Planning 2044" noting the current land fill was established in 1994 and will be closing on June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2044. Mr. Horaney noted the Agency will be creating a stakeholders group and asked the Council to consider participating.

Pilcher moved to approve the Consent Agenda which included the Minutes of the October 4<sup>th</sup>, 2021 meeting; Resolution No. 1021-3 approving the Alcohol Permit Application for Casey's General Store; and the appointment of Chris Cole to the Planning and Zoning Commission for a 5-year term. Sevcik seconded the motion and all voted aye.

The Council reviewed the FY'22 5-year Capital Improvement Plan and discussed upcoming potential projects. Mayor Hinz noted additional review and discussion will occur in the future during the FY '23 budget process.

Mayor Hinz noted the city has received an updated personnel policy and safety manual from Lynch Dallas. He added the existing documents were created in 1993 and latest revised in 2007. He asked the Council to review the new documents and provide comments by the November 1<sup>st</sup> meeting.

Sevcik moved to adjourn at 6:36 p.m., Pilcher seconded and all voted aye.
