



ROBINS CITY COUNCIL
MINUTES OF THE MARCH 15TH, 2021 MEETING

Mayor Hinz called the meeting to order at 5:30 pm in the Robins City Hall on March 15th, 2021. Roll call was taken with Councilor's Marilyn Cook, Roger Overbeck, Don Norton and Dick Pilcher present along with Police Chief Andy Humphrey, Planning and Zoning Administrator Dean Helander, Engineers Kelli Scott and Dax Suntken, and City Clerk/Treasurer Lori Pickart. There were no guests.

Norton moved to approve the Agenda, Pilcher seconded and all voted aye.

CONSENT AGENDA

Pilcher moved to approve the Consent Agenda which included the Minutes of the March 1st, 2021 meeting Resolution No. 0321-8 increasing the maximum amount for deposits at Community Savings Bank; and Resolution No. 0321-9 Transferring funds from TIF to Debt Service to pay debt. Cook seconded the motion and all voted aye.

NEW BUSINESS

Mayor Hinz noted the Comprehensive Infrastructure Plan is a part of the Strategic Future Growth Outline which was adopted on February 19, 2019. He noted Section 1.1 provides direction and the best use of the land, adding it is not etched in stone. It provides information for the 5-year Capital Improvement Plan and gives ideas and goals to keep the CIP accurate, adding it is a very good planning tool. Overbeck noted he doesn't want to be forced to do things just because the SFGO says so. It was reiterated this is a planning tool to help the Council make informed decisions. Engineer Scott noted this plan will assist developers along with staff to assist in timing for utilities. She noted it is VERY helpful to have a planning document for grant leverage. The Council agreed to have today 3/15/21 as the start date of the plan. Cook noted she was not happy putting so much on the 5-year CIP as there is no way those projects can get done in that time frame. Pilcher moved to approve Resolution No. 0321-10 adopting the Comprehensive Infrastructure Plan, Norton seconded and all voted aye.

Norton moved to adjourn at 6:30 pm, Overbeck seconded and all voted aye.
